Heart rate control:

To minimise patient inconvenience, it is preferred that beta-blocking to achieve a heart rate of 65 bpm or less be arranged by the referring physician. "Top up" beta-blocking will be performed at the time of scanning if required.

Please indicate if you do NOT wish for us to add a beta blocker on the day of the scan

It is recommended beta-blockers not to be given in setting of:

- Bradycardia (<50 bpm)
- Hypotension (<100 mmHg systolic)
- Decompensated heart failure
- Severe asthma or COPD
- Allergy or other contraindication to beta-blockers

Suggested beta-blocking protocol, at referrer's discretion:

Heart rate	Medication	Evening before scan	Morning of scan
<50	NA	NA	NA
50-60	Metoprolol	25mg	25mg
60-70	Metoprolol	50mg	50mg
>70	Metoprolol	100mg	100mg

If beta-blocker contraindicated consider Ivabradine 5mg oral evening before and morning of scan.

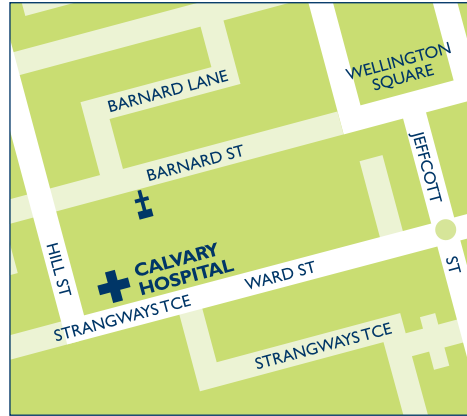

Information for Patients:

Nuclear Medicine Preparation

- NO caffeine for 24 hours i.e No tea, coffee, soft drink, chocolate, energy drinks etc.
- OK to drink water, plain milk and orange juice.
- Can have a light breakfast on the morning of examination e.g. cereal/toast
- Wear comfortable walking shoes as you may need to get on a treadmill for part of the test.
- This is an all day procedure. There are breaks in between but be prepared for it to take all day.

CT Calcium Score (only) Preparation

- Avoid coffee and caffeinated drinks for 6 hours prior.
- Do not smoke for 6 hours prior.

CT Coronary Angiogram (CTCA) Preparation

- Anticipate that your visit, depending on heart rate, may take up to 2 hours.
- **Comfortable two piece clothing is recommended, for ease of heart rate monitoring during the scan.**
- Refrain for use of Viagra/Levitra/Cialis for 72 hours (3 days) prior to your scan time, but do not stop this class of medication if it is prescribed by your physician for a heart related reason. Please inform us if you are on this medication due to potential drug interactions.
- Avoid stimulant drinks (coffee, tea, soft drink, chocolate) for 12 hours prior to your scan time.
- Please fast from food for 4 hours prior to the scan (water is allowed).
- Stay well hydrated, unless advised by your referring doctor.
